

DANCE RECITAL VOLUNTEERS

Are you interested in being a part of the behind the scenes fun?

If yes, then please join us as a backstage mom volunteer for your child's dance recital.

Responsibilities Include:

- 1) Volunteers arrive 30 minutes before show time, (same time that all dancers are required to arrive & check-in to the staging area).
- 2) Volunteers do not purchase a recital ticket.
- 3) Volunteers remain with their child's dance class during the entirety of their child's specific dance recital – except for when their child performs on stage. At that point, you'll make your way around into the **back of the auditorium** and get to see your child perform. Once they complete their dance, you'll meet them backstage again.
- 4) We ask that volunteers assist all dancers in their child's dance class with bathroom visits, costume changes and buckling or tying tap and/or jazz shoes.
- 5) Helpful tips:
 - a. The younger dancers remain occupied in the music room/dressing room with crayons and coloring books that Miss Maria provides them.
 - b. A TV monitor that streams the dance recital will be housed in the chorus classroom so the children typically sit around the TV and watch the show until it is their turn to perform.
 - c. Many parents pack snacks for their children as well as drinks that they keep with them back stage. Any parent whose child has severe food allergies is required to remain with their child back stage or make special arrangements for someone to supervise them if needed.
